St. Ignatius

With a short bench and a hot Montini goalie, the St. Ignatius varsity squad lost 8-3 on Nov. 16. Bright spots included a Tom Javorski (La Grange resident) goal with an assist from T.J. Boulger (Clarendon Hills) to tie it 1-1 in the first.

Franz Schuck buried a shot on a breakaway at the end of the first to bring the game back to within one at 3-2. But Montini continued with a swarming offense and lead 5-2 in the third. However, Chris Rubey (Western Springs) scored on assists by Tom Javorski (La Grange) and Frank DiSilvio. It was as close as the Wolfpack got, however.

The junior varsity squad remained in first place with a 1-1 tie against St. Rita Nov. 16 in a game that featured end-to-end action.

St. Rita scored early in the first on a screened tip-in. The Wolfpack battled back; penalty-killing and playing most of the game with one or, and on several occasions, two players in the box.

Franz Schuck had one goal taken off the scoreboard due to a slashing call but was

not to be denied. He came back with 1:10 on the clock in the third and scored on an end-to-end breakaway.

The contest went in to overtime and ended without any further scoring.

The next day, the varsity played a fast-skating and hard-shooting Lockport team.

However, behind acrobatic goaltending by John McConnell, the Wolfpack tied the contest 4-4.

Nate Lesiecki scored for the Wolfpack at 3:33 in the first with a blast off the faceoff, tying the game at 1. Chris Ruby (Western Springs) had his first of two goals in the contest to put St. Ignatius up 2-1 at 10:28 in the second.

Lockport came back and scored, but at the end of the second, on textbook passing from Enrique Ayala to T.J. Boulger (Clarendon Hills) to Chris Rubey (Western Springs), Rubey scored his second goal to tie the game at 3.

After another goal by Lockport, St. Ignatius' Franz Schuck took an assist from Rubey and scored to tie the game 4-4 with 1:10 left.
