

## Proposed Itinerary

Friday, June 14, 2019

Let's go to Italy! Today we will fly to Rome via Iberia or other major airline carrier.

Saturday, June 15, 2019

Upon arrival in Rome, we will visit Ostia Antiqua, the ancient port of Rome. Similar to Pompeii, the excavated remnants of the entire city can be seen and toured. After our visit, we will head to the catacombs, the burial place for early Christians, on the outskirts of downtown Rome. This evening will break into smaller groups near the Spanish Steps for dinner and, of course, gelato!

Sunday, June 16, 2019

This morning we will participate in mass at St. Peters Basilica. This afternoon we will visit the Ara Pacis, Caesar Augustus' Altar of Peace, Castel Sant Angelo, and the Pantheon. This evening we will enjoy dinner in smaller groups near the Piazza Navona.

Monday, June 17, 2019

Today we will enjoy a sightseeing tour of the Classical sites of the Eternal City with our guide. We will start with the Colosseum, followed by a walking tour of the nearby Forum Romanum. This afternoon, we'll visit tomb of St. Ignatius at the Church of the Gesu. We will also visit the rooms where St. Ignatius lived until his death in 1556 and the Church of St. Ignatius, with frescoes, a trompe d'oeil ceiling, and a magical clock. This evening, we'll enjoy dinner in smaller groups across the Tiber River in the neighborhood of Trastevere.

Tuesday June 18, 2019

This morning we will visit the sprawling Vatican complex with our guide. We will also tour the Vatican Museums and recently restored Sistine Chapel. We will revisit St. Peter's Basilica, this time with our guide, and we'll climb to the top of Michelangelo's dome. We'll end our day with an evening stroll to the Campo de Fiori for dinner.

Wednesday, June 19, 2019

We will travel to Tuscany to study the ancient Etruscans. Our first stop will be the Necropolis of Cerveteri, and its museum. After lunch, we will travel to Orvieto, a beautiful hilltop medieval city with Etruscan roots. After a visit to the Duomo, we will enjoy an underground tour of this city, visiting tunnels that are 2500 years old. We will overnight in Tuscany with an included group dinner.

Thursday, June 20, 2019

This morning, on our way to Florence, we will stop in the beautiful hilltop town of San Gimignano. Then we are off to Florence, to explore this iconic city of the Italian Renaissance, with an included dinner tonight at our hotel.

Friday, June 21, 2019

Today we will meet our guide and visit the Uffizi Gallery, one of the most important art museums in the world, which contains the Medici family's private collection. We will also enjoy a walking tour with our guide of the beautiful city, including the Baptistry and Duomo and the markets.

Saturday, June 22, 2019

After leaving Florence, we will travel to the Vatican Observatory and visit the Pope's country home, Castel Gandolfo. Tonight we will stay near the airport in Rome with an included farewell group dinner.

Sunday, June 23, 2019

This morning we will depart Rome for our flight home with memories to last a lifetime.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Air Transportation and Price: Tour includes round trip air transportation via regularly scheduled IATA air carrier. The price from Chicago is guaranteed and includes all airport taxes and airline fees.

Payment Schedule: Deposit of \$300.00 with signed application due by November 1, 2018; second payment of \$2000.00 is due by 30 November 2018; balance of due by 15 January 2019. All payments to be submitted to **BLUEPRINT TOURS**, **Inc.** Deposit to be made by personal check, bank check or money order only. Subsequent payments may be made by any method. *Credit card payments will be subject to a 3.5% credit card processing fee.* 

Cancellations and Refunds: Deposits and payments are completely refundable through 01 November 2018, **provided that notification is received by BLUEPRINT TOURS in writing by that date**. After 01 November 2018, provided that all due payments have been made to date, refunds will be issued based on the following schedule:
